## New Reading Program For 2nd & 3rd Grade Students

Reading Counts, an individualized, supplemental reading program, started the second semester with a bang for students in grades two and three! The nationally-recognized program by Scholastic, measures comprehension and other crucial reading skills through quizzes taken during regular library times on four newly-installed laptops. More than 45,000 quizzes are available to accommodate the students' interests and reading levels and may be taken on books read at home as well as at school. Quizzes may also be taken on books read aloud in class and in the library.
